What time can I arrive from?

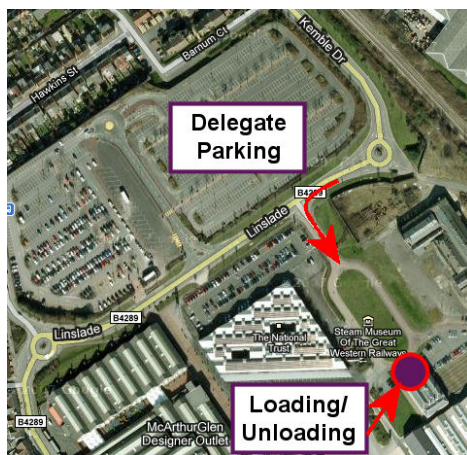
The room will be available for setting up from 8:30am on the first day. With the conference being open to attendees from 10.30am.
